Arts For Life Asheville announces openings in its Fellowship Program. The program is designed to give emerging & professional artists ways to utilize their skills to make a difference in the lives of youth. As Arts For Life Fellows, artists teach the arts to young patients in clinic and hospital settings for 9-20 hours each week. Responsibilities of the Fellows include:

- Teach the arts to patients in one-on-one and group sessions at Arts For Life's art stations in healthcare centers;
- Complete appropriate preparation and follow-up activities for lessons;
- Clean, organize, and maintain supplies;
- Develop and implement successful art projects and lessons in the artists' specific medium;
- Develop and implement at least one long-term project;
- Assist in the organization of an exhibit featuring Fellows' work and patient artwork.

Applicants should have experience teaching the arts and working with children. Fellows work with the Arts For Life team for a minimum of 1 year. Fellows must be residents of North Carolina. Compensation for the Fellowships is \$6,000-\$14,000 a year depending on experience and time committed.
